**Resolution #516 - Introducing Local Law # Providing for the Issuance of Burn Permits by the Fire Inspector**

On a motion by Councilman Tierney  
Seconded by Councilwoman Osborn

BE IT RESOLVED that an amendment to Kent Code, Article IV, Section 38-30.A(1), entitled "Precautions Against Fire, General", and Section 30.30.H is hereby introduced as Local Law # of the year 2010 before the Town Board of the Town of Kent in the County of Putnam and State of New York, to amend Article IV, Section 38-30.A(1), entitled "Precaution Against Fire, General" and to introduce a new Section 38-30.H to allow the fire inspector or his designee to issue burn permits and to restrict materials that can be hazardous; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the aforesaid proposed Amendment, which is attached hereto, be laid upon the desk of each member of the Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board will hold a public hearing on said proposed Amendment at the Town Hall, in the Town of Kent at 7:00 p.m. on January 25, 2010; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk publish or cause to be published a public notice in the official newspaper of the Town of Kent of said public hearing at least five (5) days prior thereto.

**A Local Law To Amend Town Code, Article IV, entitled "Precautions  
Against Fire, General"**

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Kent hereby amends Article IV, Sections 38-30.A(1) and 38.30.H, as follows:

Section 38-30.A(1)

Permits required under this section will be issued by the Town of Kent Fire Inspector and/or his duly authorized assistant.

Section 38-30.H

There shall be no permits issued to any person to kindle or maintain any bonfire or rubbish fire or to authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintained in the Town of Kent for the following activities:

- (1) No Leaf Burning. (6NYCRR Part 215);
- (2) No treated wood, varnished, stained, sealed, glued or otherwise adulterated wood. No pressure treated, plywood, particle board, fiberboard or oriented strand board (OSB);
- (3) No downed limbs or branches (including branches with attached leaves or needles) larger than six inches in diameter and more than eight feet long;
- (4) No open burning will be allowed nor any burn permits issued from March 15th to May 15th.
