Dear Supervisor Fleming and Kent Town Board Members,

I received the attached correspondence from Nick regarding the condition of the dump bodies on several trucks in the Highway fleet. I have personally inspected these trucks and concur with the repairs & purchases that Nick has suggested and his solution to getting our highway fleet ready for the upcoming winter season.

Seventy five percent of our fleet is twenty years or older and we are trying to find ways to utilize what we have to the best of our ability while we continue to obtain a plan for the future.

I am running out of money in my repair line. I believe these repairs should be covered out of the fund balance from 2013 due to the fact that the harsh winter contributed to the wear and tear on these trucks.

If we don't make the needed repairs prior to the 2014/2015 snow season we will jeopardize having these trucks fail during a storm and with no back up vehicles will be unable to handle our snow routes.

Good Morning,

Rich I am writing to update you on the current statues of the Highway department plow trucks. As you may know Municipal repairs is currently preparing for the winter season. Performing preventative maintenance and prepping the trucks for snow plow and sanding season. After a detailed inspection of several trucks I have come up with some cost effective and fiscally responsible recommendations for you. Regarding highway truck # 77- 2005 International 10 wheel dump truck that is a work horse in the fleet and has a good track record. The truck does not have a costly repair history and has an excellent drive train. Engine and transmission operate efficiently. My concern is the dump body. During the preventative maintenance process the tarp arms and supports needed replacement due to rusting. While attempting to replace the main support arms and cutting out the rotted supports I discovered more deterioration of the dump body wall, floor, and main head board. The main structure that supports the dump body lift piston (dog house) will need to be rebuilt and the cost to perform just this operation far exceeds the value of the remaining body which also needs patch/repair/ work to be performed. I have come up with a fiscally responsible option and that's to replace the dump body. I worked with our body supplier to give me a municipal quote for a replacement body. The cost is \$10,778.00 for the body and \$850.00 for freight. Note that the replacement body I specified would be made from A.R plate which is abrasive resistance metal. This is a perfect option for our harsh environment and would be made from 3/16 thickness metal. The current body is not of this material and thickness. I spear headed the replacement operation of 3 dump bodies last year for our sander/plow trucks and used this material and has proven to be a success. The added cost for A.R. equates to \$3000.00 and adds 5 to 7 years of life to the body.

When the body is removed from the truck I recommend having the frame preserved. Sand blasted, painted and sealed. Last year we went out to bid with three outside venders to perform this operation and have had great success with a vender that I would still recommend. The cost for frame preservation is \$2500.00. To sand and epoxy prime and paint the dump body is \$2800.00. Sum up the operation for the replacement of dump body is as follows:

Dump body, A.R. plate = \$10,778.00

Freight= \$850.00

Preserve /coat frame = \$2500.00

Paint dump body= \$\$2800.00

Roll rite tarp system= \$1900.00

Total for Highway 77 = \$18,828.00

I attached pictures and quotes for your review.

Regarding 2 other trucks in the fleet Highway truck # 23 - 1998 international 4800 series dump/sander/ plow truck and Highway truck # 28 - 1994 international 4800 series dump/sander/ plow truck are in need of replacement dump bodies. Last year to save the cost of replacing three (3) trucks we replaced 3 dump bodies and refurbished the frames of the trucks. This proved to be a success and was cost effective. I would recommend mirroring the same process. The cost for a dump body would be municipal pricing at \$24,000.00 and that is A R -450 Hardox steel. With the body off the truck that is the time to refurbish the frame, sandblast, paint and seal. Break down to replace the dump bodies on both trucks Highway 23 and Highway 28 is as follows: Replacement bodies= \$24,045.00 x 2 = \$48,090.00 Refurbish frames \$2200.00 x 2 = \$4400.00 Sand, epoxy prime and paint dump bodies= \$2800.00 x 2 = \$5600.00 Total for both trucks 23 and 28 = \$58,090.00
