Amount: The following is a breakdown of information related to program funding

- \$10,000 maximum award
- \$3,000 minimum award
- 20% cash match required

Eligible Applicants: The following entities are eligible to apply for funding through this program

- Municipalities
- Counties
- Non-profit 501(c)(3) Organizations

Please note: Sites must be owned or leased by the applicant. Lease agreements must last for a minimum of six years. If the application involves a historic site that is open to the public, it must be open at least 120 days per year. This program also requires that a New York State Historic Resource Inventory Form be completed as part of the project if the building is not listed on the State and/or National Registers of Historic Places.

Overview: Through its Preserve NY program, the Preservation League of NYS is providing support for the identification, documentation, and preservation planning of New York's cultural and historic structures. Funding may only be used for historic structure reports, building condition reports, cultural landscape reports, and cultural resource surveys. This program will not fund capital projects or cover costs related to staff overtime or grant administration. Please note that priority will be given to applicants whose projects seek to achieve the following:

- Advance the preservation of neighborhoods and downtowns that qualify for the New York State Rehabilitation Tax Credit programs;
- Continue the use of historic buildings such as museums, opera houses, theaters, and libraries for cultural, interpretive, and artistic purposes;
- Identify and preserve architecture and landscapes associated with underrepresented communities or that address issues of social justice, diversity, equity, and inclusion; and
- Respond to challenges created by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Eligible expenses include:

- Consultant fees;
- In-state travel;
- Photography; and
- Report production costs.

Past Recipients: The following entities have previously received funding through this program

- (2020) City of Binghamton, NY Department of Planning, Housing, and Community Development: A cultural resource survey for Binghamton's Main Street will include the preparation of National Register Nomination Form for National Register-Eligible Main Street Historic District, opening up the potential use of NYS and Federal Historic Tax Credits. (\$8,000)
- (2020) Town of Tompkins, NY: A building condition report will provide a professional evaluation of the Rock Rift Fire Tower to bring the tower up to safe modern standards, providing the public tower access for a greater understanding of environmental protection from both past and present. 




