DOCUMENTS

Complete sets of Bidding Documents will be issued for bidding purposes as stated in the "Notice to Bidders". A complete set of Documents consists of the following:

- 1. A copy of the Specifications
- 2. A separate set of Bid Sheets
- 3. Addenda (if any)

PROPOSALS

To be considered, Proposals on the forms included herein, must be in accordance with these Instructions to Bidders. All bids must be submitted on the prescribed forms which are included herein. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in both words and figures, either typed or in ink.

Proposals that contain any omission, erasures, alterations, additions, or items not called for in itemized Proposal, or that contains irregularities of any kind, may constitute sufficient cause for rejection of the bid. In case of any discrepancy in the price or amount bid in the Proposal, the price, as expressed in words, shall govern. All bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes addressed to the Town Clerk, Kent, New York, Putnam County, New York and be clearly identified with: (1) Bid Name, (2) Name of Bidder and Address. Proposals shall be signed with name typed below signature. The Bidder's seal, if a corporation shall be affixed under the Bidder's signature. Telephone, Facsimile or Telegraphic Bids will not be accepted.

If a separate set of proposal sheets is issued, they may be used with the understanding that all instructions and conditions of the Contract Documents are the same as if these pages were bound herein.

QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS

The Owner may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the qualifications of the Bidder to perform the work and the Bidder shall furnish information and data for this purpose as may be required. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by a Bidder, or the investigation of such Bidder, fails to satisfy the Owner, that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out obligations of the Contract and to complete the work contemplated therein within the time designated. Fraudulent statements shall cause rejections of Proposal.

The investigation of a Bidder will seek to determine whether the organization is adequate in size, is authorized to do business in the jurisdiction where the project is located, has had previous similar experience and where available equipment and financial resources are adequate to assure Owner that the work will be competed in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. The amount of other work to which the Bidder is committed may also be considered.

ADDENDA AND INTERPRETATION

Every request for information or interpretation of Bidding Documents must be addressed in writing to the Lake Carmel Park District and to be given any consideration must be received at least five (5) days prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Any and all such interpretations, and any supplemental instructions, will be in the form of written Addenda and will be mailed to all prospective Bidders. The failure of any Bidder to receive any such Addenda will not relieve the Bidder of any obligation under his Bid as submitted. Acknowledgment of Addenda shall be noted on the "Bid Form".

AWARD

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder in the manner set forth in the General Municipal Law. The Town Board reserves the right to determine responsibility based on an evaluation of the Contractor's qualifications, experience, organization, finances, past performances, and other applicable factors. The Town Board further reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The low bidder will be based on the base work alone or the base work with any or all alternate bid items, at the sole discretion of the Town Board.

OWNER

The Town of Kent, Putnam County, New York.

REQUIRED SUBMISSIONS

Following the bid opening, the apparent low bidder shall submit to the Lake Carmel Park District within seven (7) days a preliminary schedule, financial information and experience information.

Prior to award, the successful bidder will be required to meet the following requirements:

- a. The successful bidder, if his business is not registered in New York State, must provide the Town with a certificate issued by the Secretary of State of New York stating that the Corporation is authorized to do business within the State and is presently in good standing. If the entity to whom the bid is awarded is not a corporation, it would be required that the entity's certificate of doing business, which should be on file in the County Clerk's Office, be provided. (This would also hold true in the case of joint ventures which would be required to disclose the underlying entities which make up the joint venture and the supplying of the requisite certificate of doing business of each such entity.)
- b. A statement by the successful bidder that no officer, director or stockholder (if less than 10 stockholders) of the successful bidder is an officer or employee of the Town or is a relative of any such Town officer or employee. If such officer, director or stockholder does exist, their names and relationship should be disclosed to the Town.

I want to thank you for the opportunity to provide a lake management proposal for Lake Carmel. I am aware that the major aquatic problem associated with the lake is a Blue Green Algae Bloom. This problem can be controlled in order for the lake to be esthetically pleasing and useable. The following is an estimate for **Lake Carmel**.

I am recommending the following lake maintenance schedule for the summer of 2020. The lake needs to be treated with an algaecide named Cutrine Ultra and Copper Sulfate; I have attached a copy of the manufactures label for your information. You should be aware that although the treatments will clear up the algae blooms, ongoing maintenance is a **yearly** recommendation. The costs for these treatments are as follows:

I. Cutrine Ultra/ Copper Sulfate: June, July, August as needed					
Labor and Products: (2 Treatments)	\$17,650.00				
II: NYS DEC Pesticide Permit & Permit Preparation fees:	\$200.00				
III: NYS Division of Water NPDES Permit fees:	\$110.00				

Total 2020 Charges

\$17960.00

It cannot be determined at this time exactly how many treatments the lake will require. NYSDEC Regulations and the label of Cutrine Ultra are specific that only one half of the water body can be treated at a time. This is a mandatory precaution, and from my experience with the lake this past summer a good precaution. With the Carp in the lake, and the low Dissolved oxygen levels at times treating half the lake is in my professional opinion necessary. The \$17650.00 charge is for 2 treatments of Cutrine Ultra. It is imperative that at the first sign of the Blue Green Algae that the treatments begin. Two treatments should be adequate if the treatments begin at the onset of the algae blooms. If a third treatment is required to keep the lake in good condition due to a hot and dry summer the additional charge for a third treatment will be <u>\$5500.00</u>. The town will only be invoiced for treatments performed.

The prices above for the treatments include the required products, performing the application, posting the entire shoreline of the lake per NYSDEC regulations. LIFE Inc will also be performing water quality analysis of the DO (Dissolved Oxygen) levels that are needed 24 hours before and after a scheduled treatment. Water quality analysis is an important component to any application of an algaecide in a large lake.

The cost of the permits and associated fees includes the filing fees for 2 NYSDEC Pesticide Permits and one NYSDEC Division of Waters Permit. The preparation fees include hydrogeology work, creating topographical, aerial and scaled maps of the water body; preparing a downstream model and notifications to downstream owners as required by NYSDEC Regulations.

I was a residence of The Town of Kent for 28 years, and my parents lived in 7 Hills Lake for over 30 years. I have a long history with The Town of Kent and as the owner of LIFE Inc I assure you that I have the best of intentions for helping to keep Lake Carmel useable all summer; this proposal is about helping a Lake Community.

If you decide to you use my firm for this work, please sign and return a copy of this estimate, my firm will handle the permit process. Upon receipt of the signed contract I will prepare a NYSDEC aquatic permit package for your signature.



Hey Maureen,

I just wanted to follow up with the discussion we had regarding the renewal uplift relief this year. I want you to know that I've taken your request to upper management to see what could be done. As you know, we all live with standard lifts in service costs across all areas of our lives, and software is no different. We see it in movie theaters, when we take our cars in for oil changes, and with all kinds of insurance for example. In the software industry, it's set so that customers can budget for it, just as they would for annual labor increases. And the average in the software industry is 5%, based upon what we see, and companies like Springbrook use this to fund product enhancements for the customers who need a platform that evolves with them over time.

Similar to property taxes, or income taxes, Springbrook bases it's budgets on this model, so we cannot make it go away. However, we want to work with the town to show goodwill in these times.

The 3% uplift on the support and maintenance agreement is the best discount we are able to offer. The only other option is to defer the 5% uplift amount to be billed with next year's renewal. I wanted to break it down so you can see the dollars tied to each option.

Option1: (3% uplift this year) -3% uplift equals an increase of \$161.63

Option2: (5% uplift billed next year) -5% uplift equals an increase of \$271.63

As you can see, these are not unreasonable amounts. I understand that the pandemic is going on, that is why our management team has offered the options above, so you can make the choice that is best for the town. Please let me know if you would like a call to discuss, thanks!
