Discussed NYSERDA Community Campaigns: Sustainable Putnam can work with towns to launch an opt-in community solar campaign. They also are considering Putnam Clean Heating & Cooling program. This campaign requires promoting and 3 new participants (e.g., who install heat pumps) to achieve NYSERDA grant and points. Recommend both Community Solar & Clean Heating & Cooling
