Community Choice Aggregation (CCA)

- Discussed CCA and how best to approach talking to town board and growing interest.
- With understanding that even with town resolution to pursue CCA, does not mean town must commit to any CCA provider, should rates not be acceptable
- Understanding that process to move to a CCA must cover an actual, contractually guaranteed rate reduction, otherwise no residents or TB members will go for it

NYS DEC grants opportunity

- Initial thought is to pursue grant for highway dept. work in resizing or fixing culverts, etc.
- Food scrap collection at KRC may not be possible for various reasons (space, volunteer staffing, NYS DEC usage permit restrictions)
 - Collecting food scraps at a recycling center is NOT really a part of the new law
 - New law is really aimed at point-source generators of food waste, such as restaurants
 - \circ $\,$ Decision to not pursue this for food scrap collection at KRC $\,$
