## 1. Chair's report

# Correspondence

Thank-you notes

Bedford Audubon Society Newsletter

Beth pointed out that in the <u>Fall/Winter</u> and <u>Winter</u> issues of this newsletter there is information about upcoming lectures and guided nature walks in our area that may be of interest.

NYCDEP increased liability request for permits

The Chair said she would bring this issue up once again when she meets with Town Supervisor Maureen Fleming after the first of the year. She also plans to ask for a discussion regarding which Town Board member will be the CAC's liaison in 2016.

Kiosk at trail head for Mead Farm and Hawk Rock

Dave Ehnebuske presented the idea of posting a 16" x 20"map on the inside the kiosk constructed by Patrick LaFontaine for his Eagle Scout project. The map would serve as a resource for hikers. Dave would like to get it printed on aluminum and put it up near the beginning of the year.

Beth said she would like to find a volunteer to be the "caretaker" for the kiosk and keep it supplied with brochures, etc. Anne Balant-Campbell suggested her mother might be willing to do that. Beth replied that she would ask her.

Jean Ehnebuske suggested that the CAC add a QR code to the kiosk to provide hikers with information about what to watch on their walks. Beth said that if the CAC decided to do that, she would write up a "nature guide" for that purpose.

Grant opportunity with Hudson River Estuary Program

Beth stated she plans to contact the organization to learn more about the eligibility of the CAC and/or the KCF in applying for one of the recently announced grants.

Possible Eagle Scout project

Beth and Dave talked about a discussion they had each had independently with Ian Troge, a scout looking for a project at Hawk Rock. Dave suggested the scout look into constructing a boardwalk over the 30 to 50 foot swampy area on the low part of the trail to/from Hawk Rock.

The Chair asked Dave if he had set a date for the four-member Communications Committee to meet. Dave replied that he hadn't done that yet, but plans to get to it soon.
