1. Discussed with liaisons status for tree planting at Veterans Memorial/walking path area, other sites. Councilman Ruthven shared that the planting would be delayed until fall, due to weather.
2. Councilman Ruthven reported that lake treatment plan for 2020 was voted on during June 2<sup>nd</sup> town board meeting in favor of treatment and schedule TBD.
3. Councilwoman McGlasson reported that request for Beach 4 dock setup was to be delayed due to low water level, will revisit as it improves.
4. Councilwoman McGlasson reported basketball court renovation at Beach 2 was to begin week of 6/14.
5. Councilman Ruthven reported on status on ID for lake hotspots/Bruce Barber that they would contact him on update.

10. Chairman Recher and advisory board member Perez discussed interest and recommendation for lake/park district signage and include in 2020 or 2021 budget.
11. Advisory board member Perez discussed idea for Lake Carmel community cleanup day to be announced at a future date with families and in compliance with NY State Guidelines for COVID-19.
