 - The Hawk Rock trail kiosk was originally built about 5 years ago as an Eagle Scout project, along with an official blazing of the Hawk Rock trail.
 - \circ The CAC filed a police report with the Kent PD
 - All broken kiosk pieces were removed
 - The original builder is disappointed, but, also enthusiastic about rebuilding a more robust design to be reinstalled in Spring 2021
