

Lake Carmel Park District Vehicle Parking Stickers

In order to park in lots along Lake Carmel, vehicles must have current park district issued stickers issued at the Lake Carmel Park District office.

Vehicle Parking Stickers

- One sticker per vehicle will be issued. A copy of each current vehicle registration, proof of residency and photo ID are required to obtain parking stickers.

Parking Stickers should be placed on driver's side windshield of vehicle in full view.

Old parking stickers may be removed from the vehicle and submitted to the park district in order to receive a free replacement.

Homeowners

Homeowners requesting vehicle parking stickers must submit the following:

- Photo ID (Driver's License, Learner's Permit or State Issued Non Driver ID Card),
- Proof of residency (current property tax bill)
- Each vehicle registration (registered to homeowner)
- Expiration: 4 year cycle

Visitor parking passes

One (1) per household issued to homeowner for family guests to use parking lots. Visitor parking passes are used with the family guest pass to access beaches. Visitor parking passes should hang from the rear view mirror of the vehicle and are applicable for a small car load of guests; every guest should fit comfortably into the required seat belts of said vehicle.

Renters

Renters requiring vehicle parking stickers must submit the following:

- Photo ID (Driver's License, Learner's Permit or State Issued Non Driver ID Card),
- A current signed lease agreement or letter from landlord with dates of occupancy
- Each vehicle registration (registered to the renter)
- Expiration: Dec. 31st of year issued

Note: Only one visitor parking pass and family guest pass will be issued per household. Visitor and family passes will only be issued to renters if the landlord has not already obtained their passes and grants permission to issue the passes to renters.

Replacement Fee:

- A fee of \$10.00 will be charged to replace lost or destroyed vehicle parking stickers (a replacement sticker will be issued at no charge only if the old sticker is removed from vehicle and submitted to the park district office).
- A fee of \$35.00 will be charged for visitor parking passes lost or destroyed.
