("Franchisee") owns, operates and maintains a cable television system (the "System") in the Town of Kent, New York pursuant to a cable television franchise ("Franchise") granted by the governing body of the Town of Kent e and Franchisee is the current duly authorized holder of the Franchise; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an Agreement and Plan of Merger ("Agreement"), Neptune Merger Sub Corp., a Delaware corporation and a subsidiary of Altice N.V.
