Public Hearing 2024 Budget

Supervisor McGlasson asked for comments from the board and the public. There were none. Director of Finance Kelly explained the public hearing has to be closed tonight, tomorrow is the last day to keep it open. She said the budget has to be adopted by November 20th it can be adopted tonight as there are not anymore revisions. She said an average median assessed home of \$325,000 in Kent would see an average increase town tax increase of about \$60.00 to \$65.00 for the year. She said the total appropriation budget with all the districts including the Kent Fire Districts and the Library is \$21,600,000.00. She said we will be using \$1.5 million in reserves.

THIS AGREEMENT, made the _____ day of _____, 2023 by and between the COUNTY OF PUTNAM, a municipal corporation of the State of New York, having an office and place of business at 40 Gleneida Avenue, Carmel, New York 10512, (hereinafter referred to as the "County") and the TOWN OF KENT, a municipal corporation of the State of New York, having an office and place of business at 25 Sybil's Crossing, Kent Lakes, NY 10512 (hereinafter referred to as the "Town").

WHEREAS, the County is the owner of a 2000 International trailer, bearing VIN #: 1JKDLA409YA000208; and

WHEREAS, the Trailer is surplus personal property which is no longer required for County purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Town has indicated that it can utilize the trailer for official municipal purposes and that it is desirous of acquiring title and ownership of same; and

WHEREAS, the County has allowed the Town to possess and use the trailer since approximately 2014, and the Town continues to make the trailer available for County use if necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Town has maintained and renovated the trailer, including recent improvements such as structural welding, sand blasting and painting, installing an OSHA ramp safety system, installing new tires, and installing new lights; and

WHEREAS, the value of such improvements totals more than \$17,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County is desirous of transferring title and ownership of the trailer to the Town for official municipal purposes, upon the terms and conditions herein contained;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. The County shall transfer title and ownership of the trailer to the Town, and the parties will herewith complete and execute any/all documentation required by the N.Y.S. Department of Motor Vehicles to effectuate same. The Town, at its sole cost and expense, shall obtain insurance coverage for the Trailer.

2. The Trailer shall be transferred to the Town, and the Town shall accept same, in an "as is" and "where-is" condition, with no guarantees or representations made, either express or implied.
3. The Town shall only utilize the Trailer for official municipal purposes.
4. The Town shall not sell, destroy, or otherwise dispose of the Trailer without first offering the County, in writing, the option to accept title and ownership of same back without additional consideration. The County shall have sixty (60) days from the date of such written notice within which to either exercise or reject said option. If the County does not respond to the Town, in writing, within such period, the County shall be deemed to have rejected such option.
5. The Town covenants and agrees to fully and forever release and discharge the County and any and all its officers, agents, servants, representatives or employees from any and all claims, demands, rights of action or causes of action, present or future, whether same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from any cause whatsoever arising out of the transfer of the title and ownership of the Trailer pursuant to this Agreement.
6. The Town covenants and agrees to forever refrain from instituting, prosecuting, or maintaining any action, suit or proceeding, at law or otherwise, and from pressing, collecting, or otherwise proceeding against the County or any officer, agent, servant, representative, or employee of the County upon any claims, controversies, actions, causes of action, obligations, or liabilities of any nature whatsoever, whether or not presently known, which the undersigned ever had, now has, or hereafter can, shall, or may have or allege, based upon any negligence of whatsoever nature, ordinary or gross, whether or not presently known with respect to or arising out of or in connection with any personal injury, including death, or property damage arising out of the transfer of the title and ownership of the Trailer pursuant to this Agreement.
7. The Town covenants and agrees to defend, indemnify and save harmless the County and any and all its officers, agents, servants, representatives or employees from any and all claims, demands, rights of action or causes of action, present or future, whether same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from any cause whatsoever arising out of the transfer of the title and ownership of the Trailer pursuant to this Agreement.
8. The failure of the County to insist, in any one or more instances, upon strict performance of any term or condition herein contained shall not be deemed a waiver or relinquishment for the future of such term of condition, but the same shall remain in full force and effect. No waiver by the County of any provision hereof shall be implied.
9. All notices of any nature referred to in this Agreement shall be in writing and hand delivered or sent by registered or certified mail postage pre-paid, to the respective

addresses set forth below or to such other addresses as the respective parties hereto may designate in writing:

All notices shall be effective on the date of mailing.

10. This Agreement and its attachments constitute the entire Agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede all previous negotiations, commitments and writings. It will not be released, discharged, changed or modified except by an instrument in writing signed by a duly authorized representative of each of the parties.
11. This Agreement will be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of New York. Any and all disputes and/or legal actions or proceedings arising out of this Agreement shall be venued in Putnam County, New York.
12. This Agreement may be executed in two (2) counterpart originals, each of which will constitute an original and all of which, when taken together, shall constitute one Agreement.

Conveyance of Land

Highway Superintendent Othmer explained he is appearing before the PC Physical Services Committee to convey the 9 acres of land from the Highway Yard to Route 311. He explained the space is needed for their operation he anticipates their approval and the town boards. He hopes to eventually cut a road from the highway yard to Route 311 avoiding the residential road.

Response to Letter in the Putnam Press

Highway Superintendent Othmer said he gets upset and defensive when his department and the town board is bashed. He wanted to answer the questions pertaining to him, he has always invited all to his office with any issues and concerns. If you still disagree then write your letter but a conversation should take place first as to why things were done a certain way, he has back up and reasoning. He said the walking bridge in Lake Carmel has washed out two prior times before he took office and rebuilt the same way. After it washed out this time he has been working with FEMA and engineers so this does not happen again as there are many different water sources going into the culvert. Presently they have obtained soil samples for the abutments for the premade steel and concrete bridge fabricated by the University of Buffalo in their engineering program. Once the abutments are made to accommodate the bridge and flow it will go in and it will be forever. He said that is why it is taking two years. He said the next question is how much money have we bonded for the Highway Department. He said the initial bond was 3.2 million to renovate the Highway Garage and build a new garage. He said the footings, floor prep was done by the staff. He said the entire old building has been reskinned with insulation, the addition was built in the front with a carpenter and staff, he himself did the stone and block work, using his own cement mixer and scaffold. He is proud of the work being done there. He invited everyone to visit the garage. He said a 400' long and 15' high wall was built in house by Louie Strickland and Stanley Robinson for \$175,000, he said he received a quote for \$1 million to have the same wall built. He said he has come in on budget with \$40,000 left to repair the foreman's office. He said this year \$800,000 was bonded for paving. He said since Lake Carmel has 58% of the population, he is working on drainage which is not complete yet but all of Lakeshore was ready and has been paved. He addressed the next question, do we get reimbursed for shared services. He explained we share services. He said in 2013 he was given a book by Kathy Doherty for his position, he referenced chapter 4 which is all about shared services and how it is encouraged. In 2017 Gov. Cuomo came out with a county wide shared services mandate. He attended county meetings to discuss the implementation of a county-wide shared services initiative. He said he has agreements in place with Patterson, Carmel, Putnam Valley, Putnam County and NYSDOT. He said it is a fair and equitable exchange authorized and encouraged by Highway Law and saves money. He commended the town board to try to make a budget without a tax base.

-Councilman Boyd said he would like to answer a lot of questions in response to an article written in the paper by a family member. He said the first question is why the properties are under assessed. He said this was done by the previous administration that wasn't done, he said this administration has put out a bid and awarded it to have the reassessment done. He said the next question is how much will taxes go up for the 2024 budget. He said \$60.00 is an average for the town side of the town budget. Councilman Ruthven said we have an opportunity with ARPA Funding to get this done without straining our budget further. Councilman Boyd said the revaluation will not affect town as much as school taxes. The next question why did it take 4 years to write a Soil & Excavation Code. He explained in part was due to COVID, not a lot was done. He said well-crafted legislation takes a lot of conversation. Why is Lake Carmel without a Community Center? He said that started before he was on the board but since he has been here they have hired an engineer firm to give us the cost to repair and tear down and rebuild. He said the costs are \$3.5 million to renovate and \$3.6 to remove and put up a new building. If anyone has \$3.5 million dollars to come forward with we would be more than happy to put up a building tomorrow. He has spoken to others about putting together a business plan so that we can put up a building that possibly could pay for itself. Why do we not have a qualified Recreation Director? He said at present Jaime is doing the job, saving the town a lot of money. He said at some point we will have a Recreation Director. He said a Rec Director pays more in the position than Supervisor. She can step down and be the Rec Director making more money and less headache. Why are our kids going to E. Fishkill and

Patterson to participate in sports? He said he does know of some for profit organizations that are drawing some of the kids. He said it cycles through. Supervisor McGlasson said they go to Carmel United which was a travel program but now they have an in house recreation league. She said in Kent for the first time in many years we have 5 travel baseball teams in all ages and 4 travel softball teams. The fields are rented every night of the week, filled with parents and children. They might not be enrolled in our soccer programs but our fields and playgrounds are filled. She explained Laser Tag is a huge and different program, we sell out and have opened additional sessions. We are unable to handle the amount of kids interested. He said the walking bridge repair and bonding has been explained by our Highway Superintendent. Why did our board hire a law firm over \$3,000 to harass local citizens? Counsel Tagliaferro replied there is a legal process that needs to be complied with and that is what was done, we would be open to a lawsuit if it was not done. Councilman Boyd said it was a mandate not harassment and would be a failure on the board's behalf if we did not send these letters out. He said it is embellishment at best a lie at worse. Why is the town board always in executive session? He said more embellishment, they're not always in executive session, last week they were not and there are many reasons to be in executive session, one being the petition put forth, lawsuits, salaries, the board abides to Robert's Rules. They have excellent discussions, nothing is being done that is not proper. Why are we assisting a land flipper who does not live in Kent with easement of possible spot zoning change? Councilman Boyd does not believe anyone sitting on this board has used the word spot zoning as a potential for the Sunberry property. He knows there will not be a lot done there soon. He agrees we should have better contract written about it. It doesn't matter if they live here or not as long as they abide by the law. He welcomes constructive criticism he does not want to reinvent the wheel. The board wants positive public input from the public and not embellishment and stuff that is not true. He said the board gets along well he thinks they do a great job. Councilman Ruthven wishes he didn't have to go into executive session to receive the reports Nancy informs them on or personnel issues that they have to deal with but that is the life of being on the town board.

- The Kent Library is accepting library fines by making them with non-perishable food donations.
- Veterans Appreciation is at the Kent Library. Veterans can fill a bag of books for \$10.00.
- There are a few crafting events being held for Thanksgiving tomorrow at 11:00 a.m. for young children, at 1:00 p.m. for adults at the Kent Library.
- Councilman Pompuri thanked the Kent Sanitation, Kent Highway and the Kent Police Department for their services. He said this town is great, is it perfect of course not, and no place is perfect but it is perfect for him and his family.
- Councilman Pompuri congratulated his daughter Georgia who is being inducted into the National Honor Society this Thursday.
- Councilman Pompuri said it has been an honor and a pleasure to be a coach to the 2023 Carmel Rams Football Team. They are the three time Section I AA Champions. They are playing this Saturday Shenandoah at 3:00 p.m. in Mahopac in the State Quarter Finals. He said it couldn't be done without the players, cheerleaders, parents, the booster club but also the Carmel Community.

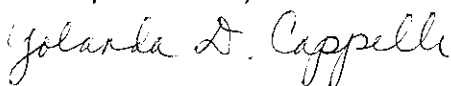
